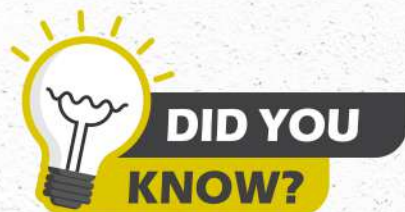

A dash of cinnamon or nutmeg (optional)

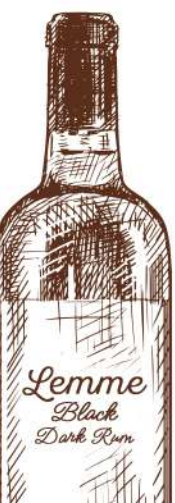
Whipped cream (optional, for garnish)
